

The Weaver's Choice Heddle opens up endless opportunities for creative weaving. The weaver is no longer confined to a single size warp yarn or even a manufacturer's predetermined section of warp size. With the Weaver's Choice it is possible to use bulky yarns side by side with lightweight fingering yarn in the same project, all on one heddle!

The Weaver's Choice is available in 8", 16", 24" and 32" sizes to fit each of the Kromski Harp Forte Looms.

Included in the Weaver's Choice package are:

4 wooden frame pieces - per size: Two of them are flat on one side with the Kromski logo stamp. The other side has a "shelf". The other two are flat on one side with no logo and curved on the other side.

2 Metal Brackets - per size.

Brass Knobs, Washers and Screws (6 each for the 8" and 16", 8 each for the 24" and 32")

Each heddle comes with an assortment of individual heddle pieces 12, 10, 8 and 5 dent.

The 8" includes 20 of each. The 16" includes 40 of each. The 24" includes 60 of each. The 32" includes 80 of each.

The heddle frame itself is composed of the 4 wooden parts that sandwich the heddle pieces between the back and front. The top and bottom pieces of the frame are secured with metal brackets and are held together by bolts.


The individual heddles are notched on either end and snap together in endless combinations.

Assembling the Weaver's Choice Heddle for use:

Place the 2 wooden frame pieces with the logo face down on a flat surface, one above the other with the recessed shelves facing each other. Insert the Screws into the holes so that the threaded ends face up.

The metal braces should be placed onto the outermost screws first to create more stability for the frame when fitting together the plastic heddle pieces later. Be sure to place the thicker strip of metal outside of the hole on the brace toward the ends of the heddle frame pieces, as noted on the next page.



Place the series of heddle pieces that you have determined for your project so that they rest in order on the recessed shelf on both the top and bottom pieces of the frame. Next, snap the pieces together one by one. Notice the heddles are flat on one side and shaped on the other. These ridges should face



Follow with additional heddle pieces until the desired pattern is achieved.

You may choose to create a well thought out symmetrical pattern or a random pattern with various sized yarns.

With the Weaver's Choice the choice is yours!

Kromski recommends that the entire frame be filled with heddles even if you plan to weave a narrow piece. This will ensure stability as you weave.



Once all of the heddle pieces are in place, set the curved pieces of the wood frame over the screws with the thicker part facing the center, followed by the washers and brass knobs.

Tighten to secure.

The Weavers Choice Heddle is now ready for use.
